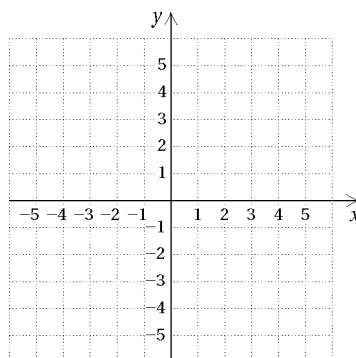
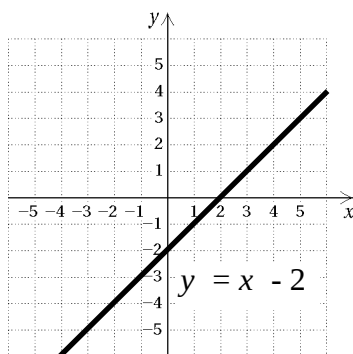

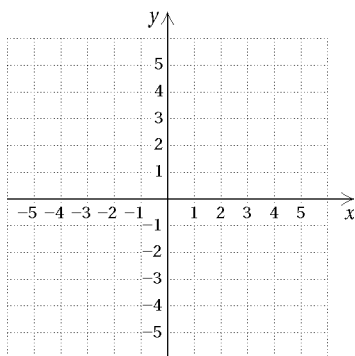

Example: Graph. $y = x - 2$

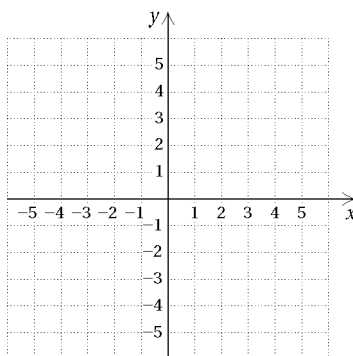
x	y	(x, y)

2	0	$(2, 0)$



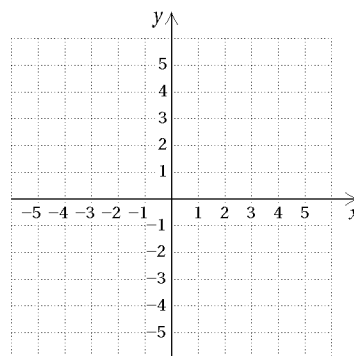
2. $y = 2x - 3$



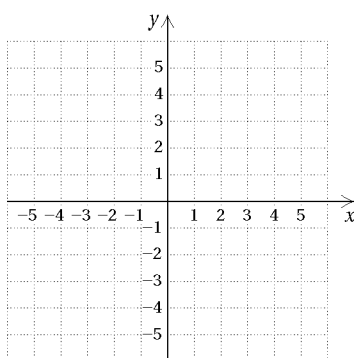
3. $y = x + 4$



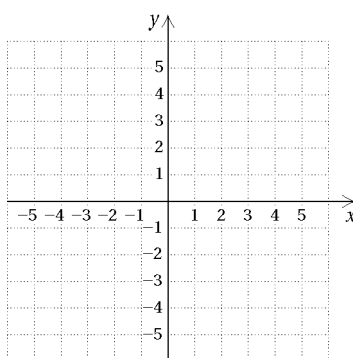
4. $y = -3x + 2$
